

# Studio Policies

## Dress Code

All students are required to wear dress code for every class. Students that come to class not wearing dress code may be asked to sit out for that class or may be sent home. Please make sure your students understand this policy.

Girls- Black Leotard, Black booty shorts/skirt, tan tights, appropriate shoes for each class. Hair up in ponytail (bun for ballet). Dance Envy t-shirts will not be allowed this year.

Boys- Black shirt (No graphics or wording), black shorts/pants, appropriate shoes for each class. Dance Envy shirts will not be allowed this year.

**Each student must sign the dress code form before starting classes.**

## Tuition

Tuition is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. A \$10.00 late fee will be applied on the 5<sup>th</sup>. We accept cash or check, or you can pay online through your parent portal. Tuition is based on a 42-week dance year. Payments are broken up into 10 monthly payments for your convenience. Tuition is nonrefundable and is paid to save your child's place in class. If your child has decided to stop attending class, you must fill out a "Drop Class" form at least 2 weeks before payment is due. If we are not contacted, we will continue to bill you for saving your child's place.

You are not charged for any holiday closings, including Thanksgiving Break, Christmas Break, Winter Break, Spring Break or the remainder of June after Recital.

## Snow or Bad Weather

Dance Envy will follow the Somersworth school district for all snow and bad weather cancellations. Classes will be made up either during vacation weeks or another time at the discretion of the instructor.
